OPPORTUNITY AND ACCESS


Employees of California's life sciences sector are a **well-educated and diverse** workforce, holding a **shared objective to increase health equity and access to care** for all Californians.

Promoting gender diversity:



In 2019, **female life sciences graduates** made up **62.7% across all degree levels** in CA.

Building a diverse workforce:



From 2015 to 2019, **Hispanic and Latino graduates** in life sciences-related fields of study in CA **increased by 64.5%**

Promoter of small businesses:



Over 80% of life sciences establishments in California have **10 or fewer employees.**

Life sciences are an engine for **innovations** that not only advance medical breakthroughs but also help solve our climate crisis, improve agriculture, transition to cleaner energy, and overall **better the lives of everyday Californians.**

Leader in patents:



CA is a standalone leader in awarding life sciences patents, **issuing 45.1 per 1,000** in Science & Engineering in 2019.

More than 25% of all COVID-19 vaccine developments in the U.S. have been sponsored or primarily supported by life sciences organizations in CA.

The bioscience industry is building a world with **safer, more affordable and sustainable practices** that address climate change.
