Grant Deed.

Mission Hills Company, a corporation, of the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California.

For and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars,

Does Hereby Grant to P.E. Lundblade of San Diego, California,

All That Real Property Situated in the city of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, bounded and described as follows:

villa Lot One Hundred and Three (103) of Mission Hills, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to the official map thereof filed in the office of the County Recorder of said County January 20th, 1908.

Provided, However, that this conveyance is made and accepted on each of the following conditions, which are hereby made covenants, running with the land, and which shall apply to and be binding upon the grantee, his heirs, devisees, executors, administrators and assigns, namely:

~~That no part of the premises hereby conveyed shall ever be conveyed, transferred or devised to any person other than the White or Caucasian race.~~

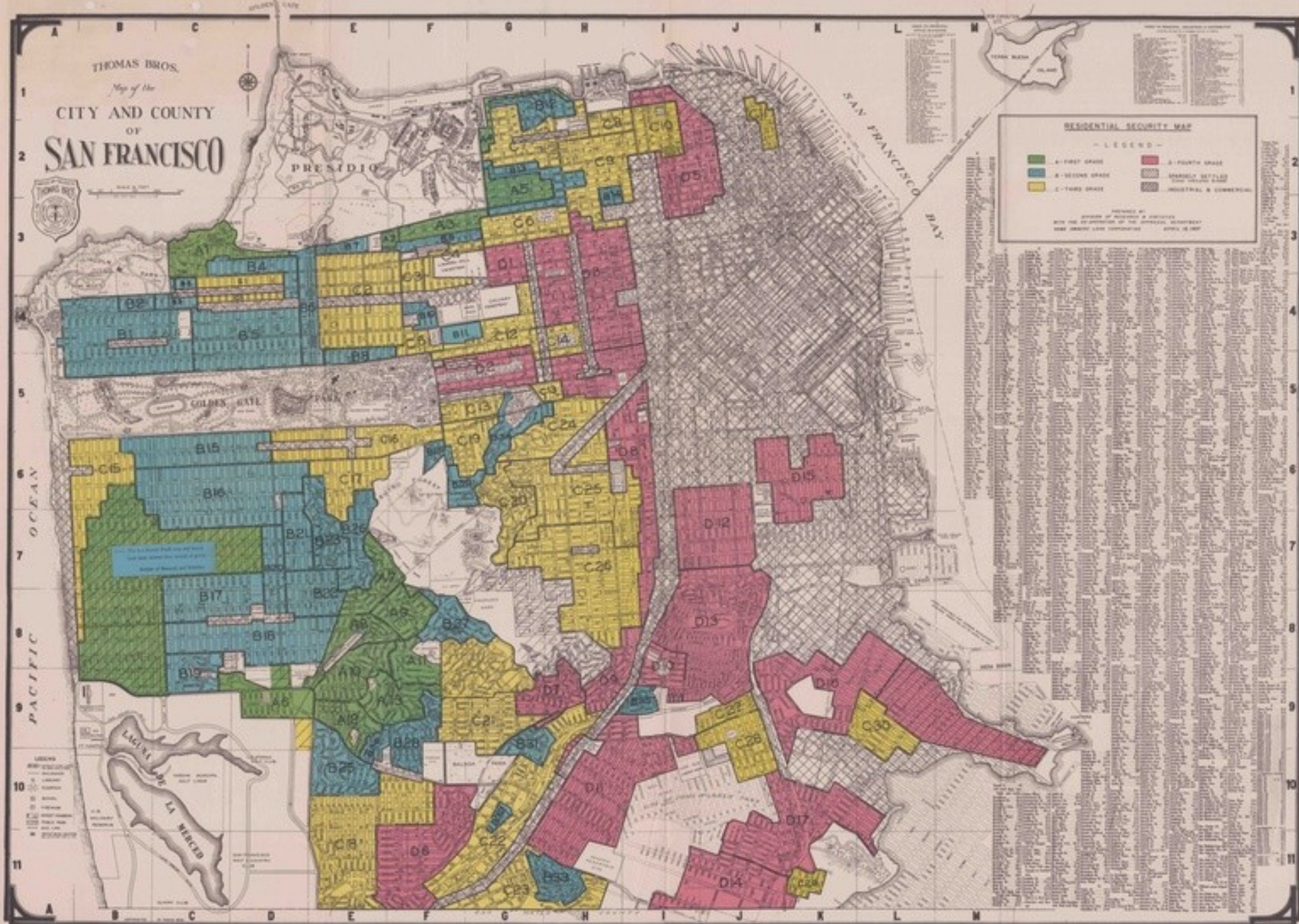
To Have and To Hold the above granted and described premises, unto the said grantee his heirs or assigns forever. Subject to the taxes assessed in 1910 which the purchaser agrees to pay.
