Responsibilities include advising the Committee Chair, Assembly members, and staff; analyzing proposed legislation; reviewing the quality of other consultants' work; negotiating bill amendments; staffing bills within the Committee's jurisdiction on behalf of the Chair; planning informational hearings; and supervising and managing a staff of three. The ideal candidate should be adept at critical thinking and independent research and must have the ability to succeed in a fast-paced and high-pressure work environment. This is a collegial and supportive office.

The Assembly salary range for the classification of Chief Consultant is between \$9,694 and \$23,090 monthly. The successful candidate's salary for this position is anticipated to be between \$15,000 and \$18,000 monthly.
