JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Democratic Office of Communications and Outreach (DCO) is seeking a Caucus Communications Consultant to focus on Social Media outreach to manage and grow the Assembly Democratic Caucus' social media platforms. Based in Sacramento, this position works collaboratively on a team to develop and execute a comprehensive social media outreach that grows audiences, engages and retains followers, and effectively communicates the work of the Caucus and its members.

The ideal candidate will know how to bring a concept to life as a compelling narrative through video, photo, and imagery, illustrating the value of legislation and the work of Assemblymembers to their constituents. Candidates should be comfortable working in a fast-paced environment, managing multiple projects simultaneously, collaborating across teams, and working extended hours as needed when legislative functions dictate. Bilingual (English/Spanish) literacy is a plus.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Create, edit and assist with posting compelling social media content using video, photos, graphics and audio that highlights the value of legislation and the caucus' work for constituents throughout California
- Develop, implement, and oversee a comprehensive social media outreach for the Assembly Democratic Caucus

- Manage daily operations of DCO social media accounts, including content planning, scheduling, and publishing
- Monitor trends, emerging platforms, and best practices to keep Caucus social media content timely and relevant
- Use social media analytics and performance data to evaluate, refine, and optimize content and strategy
- Monitor Assemblymembers' websites and communications for updated materials and suggest content opportunities
- Maintain an intermediate to advanced working knowledge of the Assembly Democratic Caucus and its members
- Lead and conduct workshops for internal staff and member offices on social media best practices and emerging trends
- Perform other related duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

- Minimum of 3-5 years of social media, photography and video production experience
- Ability to film and produce short-form video content, plus capture still photos for social media

- Strong understanding of major social media platforms and social media management tools
- Excellent writing and communication skills, with the ability to tailor messaging for diverse audiences
- Experience with short-form copywriting, short-form video production, and basic graphic design
- Knowledge of California and national political and policy issues
- Ability to work effectively in a fast-paced environment, manage multiple projects, and meet tight deadlines
- Ability to work extended hours when legislative function or deadlines for work require
- Ability to collaborate effectively within a team and across departments
- Strong organizational and time-management skills
- Willingness and ability to work extended hours as required by legislative functions
